SGMA and Groundwater Management

SGMA = Sustainable Groundwater Management Act

- State law passed in 2014
- Local agencies given authority and responsibility to manage groundwater: Groundwater Sustainability Agencies = GSA
 - Develop and Adopt a Groundwater Sustainability Plan GSP, by 2022
 - Implement Projects and Policy Actions to Achieve Sustainability
 - 3. Monitoring and Reporting Every Year
 - 4. Achieve Sustainability by 2042

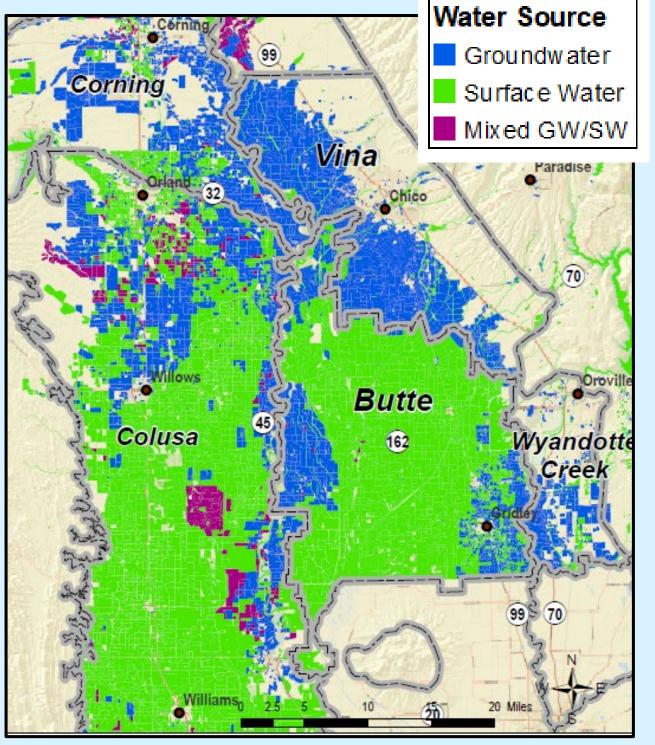






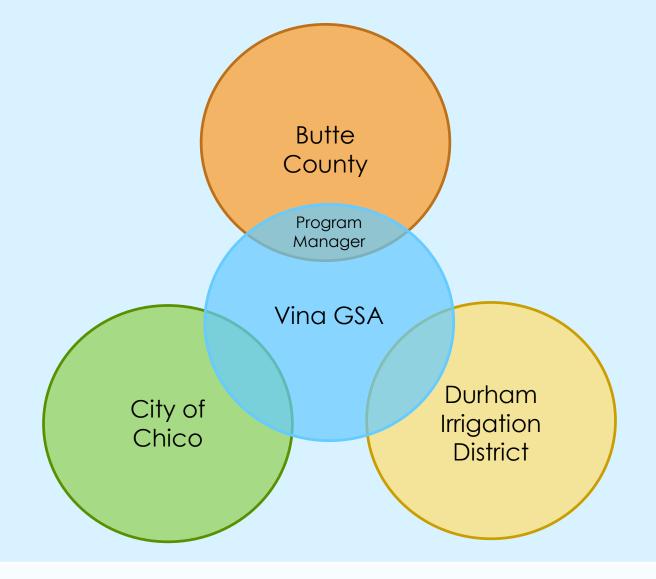
Land & Water Use in Vina

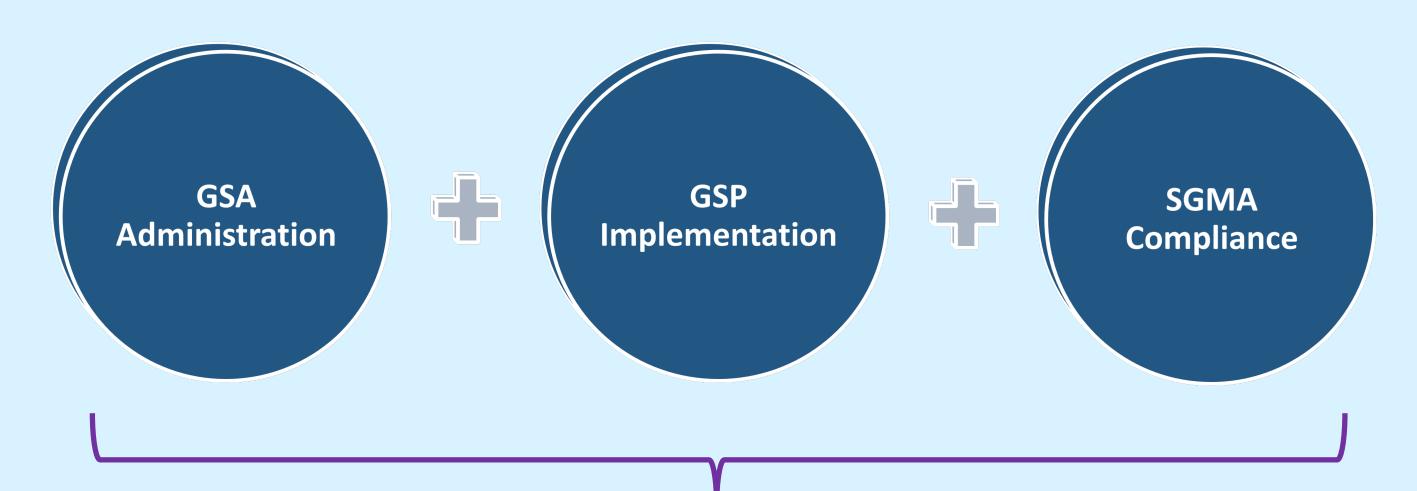

DWR grant: ~\$1.5M Member In-Kind Contributions Moving forward, the GSA needs a new sustainable funding source by 2024.



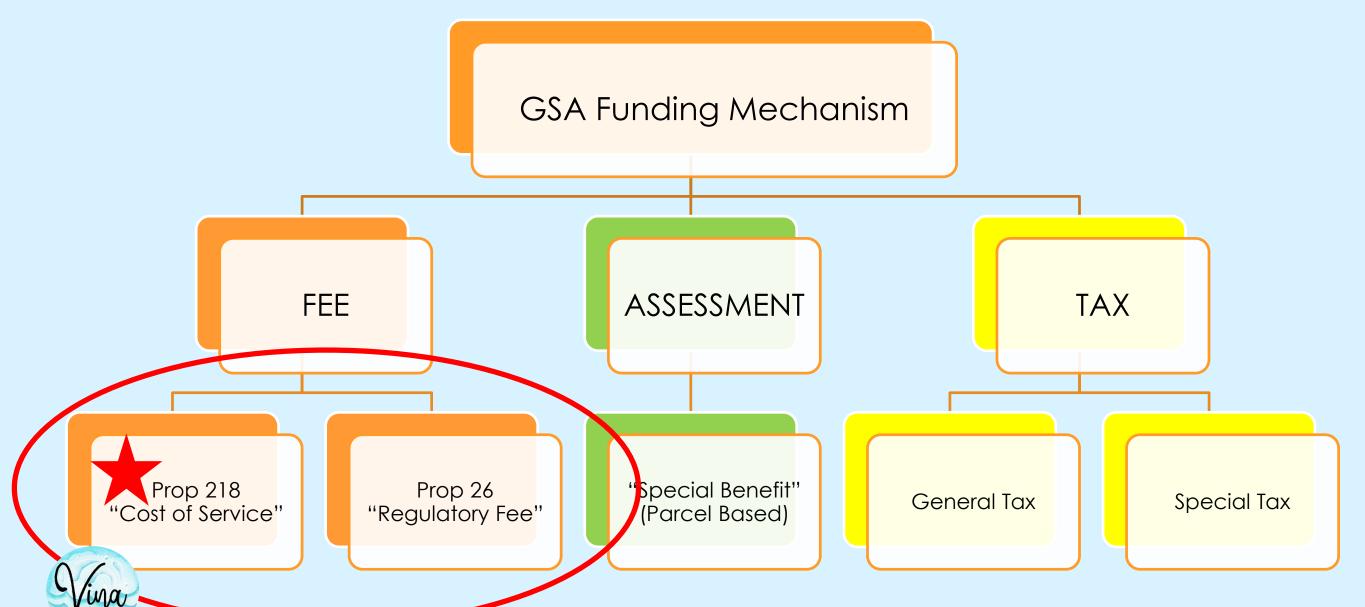
Need for Long-Term Funding

Developing a Fee Under 218

- 1. Identify costs
- 2. Confirm revenue needs
- 3. Develop alternative cost allocation methods
- 4. Preparation of a Technical Memorandum (TM)
- 5. Preparation of the Engineer's Report/Fee Study
- 6. Cost allocation and fee approval public hearing
- 7. Fee placed on Assessor's Tax Roll

- Option 1: Butte County DWRC Program Manager to be funded by the GSAs.
 - Option 2: GSA hires Consultant(s) for management and operations.
 - Option 3: GSA hires employees/staff.

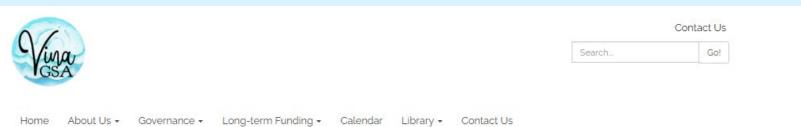

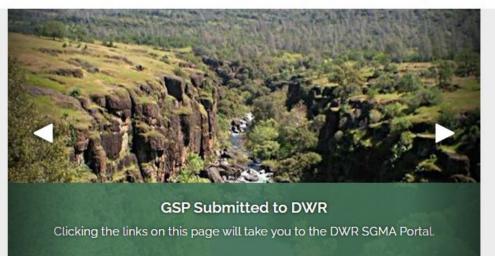

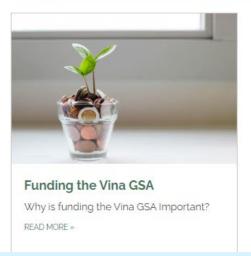
